A fiber optic patch cord can bridge gaps when your existing fiber cable is too short, providing flexible, reliable connections between devices or panels.

What a Fiber Optic Patch Cord Is

A fiber optic patch cord (also called a fiber jumper) is a short section of optical fiber with connectors on both ends, designed for flexible, short-distance interconnections within a network. Unlike permanent backbone cables, patch cords are dynamic and connect servers to switches, patch panels to equipment ports, or cross-connect fiber routes in data centers and colocation environments ().

Choosing the Right Patch Cord

When selecting a patch cord, consider:

- Fiber type: Single-mode (SM) for long distances, multimode (MM) for shorter distances ().
- Connector type: LC, SC, MPO, or others depending on your equipment ().
- Length: Ensure the cord is long enough to reach between devices without excessive tension, but avoid unnecessary slack ().
- Bend-insensitive fiber: Useful in tight spaces or FTTH applications ().
