

Number of digits in industrial power distribution boxes



Article Overview

Industrial power distribution boxes typically use unique identification numbers, often 3 to 5 digits, to label panels, circuits, and equipment for clear identification and maintenance.

Standard Numbering Practices

In industrial settings, each distribution box, panelboard, or circuit is assigned a unique identification number to avoid confusion and facilitate computerized tracking, preventive maintenance, and operational management (Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory standard) . These numbers serve as the prime reference for panelboards and circuits and are supplemental to NFPA 70 requirements.

- **Digit Range:** Most industrial systems use 3 to 5 digits for numbering, depending on the facility size and complexity. Smaller installations may use 3-digit numbers, while large plants with multiple panels and circuits may require 4 or 5 digits to ensure uniqueness.
- **Structure:** The numbering often starts with a panel or box identifier, followed by a circuit or branch number. For example, a number like 1023 could indicate panel 10, circuit 23.
- **Consistency:** Numbers are assigned sequentially or according to a logical hierarchy (e.g., by building, floor, or voltage level) to simplify maintenance and troubleshooting....
