

OLT to Splitter Test



Article Overview

Testing an OLT to PON splitter involves measuring optical loss and verifying that each splitter port meets the defined loss budget using an OLTS or PON-optimized OTDR.

Overview

An OLT to splitter test is performed to ensure that the optical signal from the OLT is properly distributed across all splitter outputs and that the loss is within acceptable limits. This is critical for maintaining service quality in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) or Passive Optical LAN (POL) networks .

Tools Required

- Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS): Measures insertion loss and verifies that each splitter port meets the expected loss budget .
- PON-optimized OTDR: Useful for characterizing splitters, splices, connectors, and locating faults in the network .
- Fiber Inspection Scope: Ensures connectors are clean and undamaged before testing, preventing measurement errors .
- Wavelength Multiplexers/Filters: Allow testing at non-operational wavelengths (e.g., 1625 nm) without disrupting active services .

Testing Procedure

- Inspect Connectors: Use a fiber inspection scope to check all connectors at the OLT and splitter ports for dirt or damage .
- Connect OLTS: Attach the OLTS transmitter to the OLT port and the receiver to ea...
