An ONU (Optical Network Unit) converts fiber-optic signals to electrical signals for end users, while OSFP is a high-speed pluggable transceiver standard supporting 400G/800G Ethernet for scalable optical connectivity.

Optical Network Unit (ONU)

An ONU is a critical device in Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) and other FTTx networks, operating within a Passive Optical Network (PON) architecture. It receives optical signals from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office and converts them into electrical signals for end-user devices such as routers, computers, and phones . Key features of modern ONUs include:

- Ethernet and Wi-Fi interfaces for wired and wireless connectivity
 - Voice ports (POTS) for VoIP services
 - PoE capability to power devices like IP cameras or access points
 - Remote management protocols such as TR-069 or OMCI for configuration and monitoring
- ONUs provide high-speed connectivity, scalability across different PON technologies (GPON, EPON, 10G-PON), and cost efficiency by minimizing active equipment between the provider and end user . They are essential for delivering broadband, IPTV, and telephony services over a single fiber.
