

Optical Cable Construction Process



Article Overview

The optical cable construction process involves manufacturing the fiber, preparing the site, laying the cable, splicing, testing, and final network integration.

1. Fiber Manufacturing

The process begins with creating the optical fiber itself. High-purity silica (SiO_2) is refined into a preform, a thick glass rod, which is then heated in a furnace to around $2,000^\circ\text{C}$ and drawn into a thin fiber approximately 125 microns in diameter, about the thickness of human hair . The fiber is immediately coated with a protective layer, cured with UV light, and may receive additional layers for durability, including buffer tubes, strength members like Kevlar® or steel rods, and an outer jacket made of PVC, LSZH, or polyurethane .

2. Project Planning and Site Preparation

Before installation, engineers conduct a site survey to map routes, assess terrain, and identify obstacles such as existing utilities or waterways . Planning includes selecting the appropriate fiber type (Single Mode or Multi-Mode), estimating costs, obtaining permits, and scheduling milestones . Site preparation involves clearing the route, cleaning pipelines, pre-laying conduits, steel wires, or hooks for overhead installation, and excavating trenches for direct burial .
