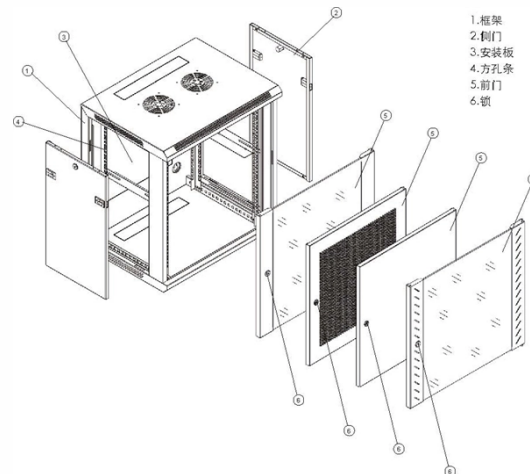


Optical Port Module and Electrical Port Module

Optical port modules transmit data as light over fiber, enabling long-distance, high-bandwidth communication, while electrical port modules transmit data as electrical signals over copper cables, ideal for short-distance, cost-effective connections.

Electrical Port Modules

Definition and Function: Electrical port modules, also called optical-to-electrical port modules, are hot-swappable devices with an SFP form factor that use RJ45 connectors and UTP copper cables as the transmission medium. They convert electrical signals for short-distance Ethernet communication, typically under 100 meters . **Applications:** These modules are commonly used to connect server NICs and switches without requiring fiber optic upgrades, supporting speeds up to 10G depending on the module type . **Types:**

- **Fast Ethernet (100M):** Used with 100BASE-T SFP ports; limited scenarios due to native RJ45 ports on most switches.
 - **Gigabit (1G):** Supports multiple modes like SGMII-to-10/100/1000BASE-T and 1000BASE-X-to-1000BASE-T; selection depends on switch type.
 - **10 Gigabit (10G):** Required for 10G SFP ports where native 10G-T RJ45 ports are unavailable; higher power consumption and heat dissipation must be considered .
- Advantages:** Lower cost, easier installation, lower power consumption, and minimal risk of physical damage compared to optical modules . **Limitations:** Short transmission distance, susceptibility to electromagnetic interference (EMI), and sign...
