Common Causes of Optical Module Interruptions

- **Compatibility Issues:** Using non-certified or incompatible optical modules can prevent proper operation, even if the hardware appears intact .
- **Port or Configuration Mismatch:** Incorrect port settings, such as mismatched speed, duplex mode, or auto-negotiation settings, can prevent the module from establishing a link .
- **Signal Degradation:** Dirty, scratched, or damaged fiber connectors can cause high signal attenuation, resulting in dropped data or unstable links .
- **Environmental Factors:** Electrostatic discharge (ESD), overheating, or poor seating of the module can also interrupt operation .

Troubleshooting Steps

- **Verify Module and Port:** Check that the optical module is certified and matches the port specifications. Use commands like `display interface` or `show interfaces transceiver detail` to confirm parameters such as rate, wavelength, and DDM readings .
- **Inspect Physical Connections:** Ensure fiber connectors are clean and undamaged. Use an optical power meter to measure receive power and check for disconnections...
