What is an Optical Module?

An optical module is a hot-pluggable transceiver used in high-bandwidth data communications, bridging electrical signals from network devices to optical signals transmitted over fiber optic cables and vice versa . It typically consists of:

- TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts electrical signals into optical signals using a laser diode or LED .
- ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals .
- PCBA and functional circuits: Manage signal processing and control.
- Optical interface: Connects to fiber optic cables, supporting single-mode or multi-mode fibers .
- Electrical interface: Connects to switches, routers, or servers, often following standards like SFP, SFP+, QSFP, or QSFP-DD .

- SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable): Supports 1G/10G Ethernet.
- SFP28: Designed for 25G links....
