An overpass is a type of bridge designed to carry one roadway over another road, railway, or human-made obstacle, typically using beam, arch, or truss structures to manage traffic loads efficiently.

Definition and Purpose

An overpass is a bridge specifically constructed to allow one road or highway to pass over another without intersecting, improving traffic flow and safety in urban or high-traffic areas . Unlike standard bridges that often span natural obstacles like rivers or valleys, overpasses primarily cross human-made infrastructure such as roads or railways . They are generally shorter in length and height compared to long-span bridges .

Structural Types

Overpasses can utilize several structural forms depending on span length, load requirements, and site conditions:

- **Beam Bridges:** The simplest and most common type, consisting of a horizontal deck supported at both ends by abutments or piers. Beam bridges handle vertical loads primarily through bending, with the top of the beam in compression and the bottom in tension. They are suitable for short spans, often less than 200 feet .
- **Arch Bridges:** Effective for slightly longer spans, arch bridges convert vertical loads into horizontal thrusts at the supports, placing the structure mainly in compression. They are ideal where solid foundations exist to resist horizontal forces
