

# Parallel wiring of home distribution box



## Article Overview

Parallel wiring (jumper connections) in household distribution boxes is unsafe and prohibited; each circuit breaker should have a dedicated wire from the main switch.

### What Parallel Wiring Means

Parallel wiring, often called a jumper connection, occurs when multiple wires are connected together to feed several circuit breakers from a single terminal. For example, a wire from the main switch may connect to the first breaker, and then additional wires “jump” from the top of one breaker to the next to supply multiple circuits . While this may seem convenient, it is explicitly prohibited by national standards due to safety hazards.

### Hazards of Parallel Wiring

- **Overloading:** The wire closest to the main switch carries the sum of currents from all downstream breakers. This can exceed the wire's rated capacity without tripping the breakers, creating a hidden overload .
- **Heat buildup:** Thick wires needed for jumpers can crowd the distribution box, reducing heat dissipation and increasing fire risk .
- **Non-compliance:** Using jumpers violates electrical codes and can lead to inspection failures or legal issues . For example, a 4 mm<sup>2</sup> copper wire has a maximum current capacity of 25A. If it carries the combined load of multiple circuits, it may overheat even if individual breakers are rated lower .
