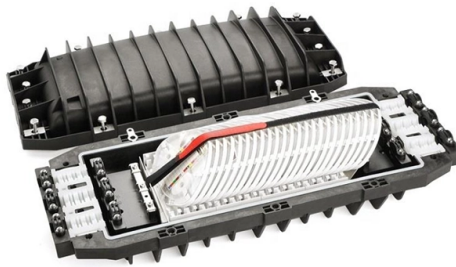


Philippine Passive Optical Network 40G
