

Place the mesh cable tray on top of the server rack



Article Overview

To install a mesh cable tray above a server rack, select the right tray, plan the route, mount secure supports, assemble the tray, and carefully route and secure cables while maintaining airflow and expansion space.

Step 1: Select the Appropriate Tray

Choose a wire mesh cable tray suitable for the type and weight of cables you plan to run. Wire mesh trays are ideal for server rooms because they allow airflow, are flexible for rerouting, and support high-density cabling. Ensure the tray width accommodates current and future cable loads.

Step 2: Plan the Cable Path

Determine the optimal route above the server rack, considering:

- Entry and exit points for cables
- Clearance from ceiling, lighting, and HVAC systems
- Future expansion needs
- Separation of power and data cables to reduce interference

Step 3: Mark and Install Support Structures

- Mark support points above the rack, typically spaced 1.5-2 meters apart depending on the weight of the cables and the tray.
