A PoE switch is powered by connecting its power input to a compatible AC or DC PoE power supply, enabling it to deliver both data and power to connected devices over Ethernet cables.

Steps to Connect a PoE Switch

1. Verify Power Requirements: Check the PoE switch specifications for voltage and power input type. Most PoE switches accept standard AC input (e.g., 100–240V AC) or a DC PoE injector if designed for remote powering . 2. Choose the Correct Power Supply: Ensure the power supply matches the switch's input rating and provides sufficient wattage to support the switch's total PoE budget. The PoE budget is the maximum power the switch can deliver to connected devices, and it must exceed the combined power requirements of all powered devices (PDs) you plan to connect . 3. Connect the Power Supply:

- For AC-powered switches, plug the power cord from the AC outlet into the switch's power input port.
- For DC-powered or midspan setups, connect the PoE injector or DC power source to the switch's designated power input port . 4. Connect Ethernet Cables to PoE Ports: Use Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6A cables to connect the switch to PoE-enabled devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, or wireless access points. The switch will automatically detect PoE-compliant devices and negotiate the required power using IEEE 802.3af/at/bt standards . 5. Power-On and Verify: Turn on the power supply. The swi...
