Ceramic flanges are used in high-temperature, corrosive, and wear-intensive applications, requiring high flatness, surface smoothness, and precise bolt-hole alignment for effective sealing and long-term performance . Polishing is essential to remove micro-scratches, surface irregularities, and waviness from the as-fired ceramic, ensuring a consistent, high-quality surface for sealing and metallization if needed .

Mechanical and Diamond Abrasive Polishing

Mechanical polishing typically involves lapping and polishing with diamond abrasives on composite or cast-iron plates. The process is staged:

- Stock removal stage: Removes surface irregularities at a rate of approximately 1 μm per minute using coarse abrasives.
- Fine polishing stage: Achieves ultra-smooth surfaces with removal rates around 0.3 μm per minute using finer abrasives and plastic-faced conditioning rings .
- Surface finish: Ra values as low as 0.003 μm can be achieved, ensuring excellent flatness and sealing capability . Diamond abrasives, such as aluminum oxide or silicon carbide, are preferred for their hardness and ability to process brittle cerami...
