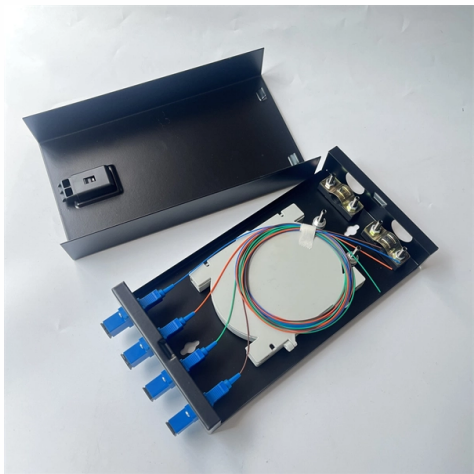

Key Design Considerations

- Load Capacity: Depends on tray width, height, material thickness, and support spacing. Ladder trays with thicker side rails support heavier cables and longer spans .
- Cable Fill Ratio: Maximum allowable cross-sectional area of cables relative to tray cross-section. Typically, 40–50% fill is recommended to allow ventilation and future expansion .
- Rung Spacing (Ladder Trays): 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) is standard to support cables while allowing airflow .
- Material Selection: Steel (galvanized, stainless), aluminum, or fiberglass, chosen b...
