

Power Distribution Box Wiring Terminals



Article Overview

Power wiring terminals in a distribution box connect incoming power to protective devices and distribute it safely to multiple circuits.

Overview of Terminals

In a distribution box, terminals are the points where wires are securely connected to allow electricity to flow safely to different circuits . These include:

- Phase (Live) terminals: Connect the incoming live wire from the main supply to the main MCB or main switch. This terminal distributes power to all outgoing circuits through individual MCBs or RCBOs .
- Neutral terminals (Neutral link/bar): Distribute the neutral wire to all output circuits. Each single-pole MCB output connects its neutral to this bar to complete the circuit .
- Earth terminals (Earth link/bar): Connect the incoming earth wire and provide grounding for all circuits and devices, ensuring safety against electrical shocks .

Types of Terminal Blocks

Distribution boxes often use terminal blocks to organize and secure connections:

- Screw-type terminals: Wires are clamped using screws, providing a strong mechanical and electrical connection .
- Push-in or spring clamp terminals: Allow quick insertion of solid or stranded wires without screws, saving installation time and ensuring reliable contact .
- Stud or bolt terminals: Used for high-current connections, where wires are secure...
