Safety First

Before working in a distribution box, turn off the main power supply to prevent electric shock or short circuits. Always use insulated tools and wear protective gloves and eyewear. Never attempt to jumper wires in a live panel, as this can cause serious injury or fire .

Choosing the Right Jumper Wire

- **Wire Type and Size:** Use wires rated for the panel's voltage and current. For example, copper wires are commonly used for their conductivity, but ensure the gauge matches the load requirements .
- **Compatibility:** If connecting aluminum and copper wires, use anti-oxidant compounds or approved connectors to prevent corrosion and overheating .
- **Pre-manufactured Jumpers:** Terminal block or circuit breaker-specific jumpers are recommended for industrial or residential panels, as they are designed to fit securely and handle the expected current .
