Mechanical Protection

Fiber optic cables are highly sensitive to bending, stretching, and crushing. To prevent damage:

- Respect the minimum bend radius: Single-mode fibers typically require a bend radius of at least $10\times$ the cable diameter, while multimode fibers require $7.5\times$ the diameter. Exceeding this can cause micro-cracks or complete signal loss .
- Use bend-insensitive fibers in tight-routing scenarios.
- Employ cable management hardware such as bending guides, radius limiters, and slack storage units to enforce proper routing .
- Avoid excessive pulling or tension during installation to prevent internal fiber breaks .
