Patch cords are generally more expensive per unit than pigtailes due to the dual connectors, factory testing, and protective materials .

- Fiber Type: Single-mode (SMF) fibers are typically more costly than multimode (MMF) fibers, especially for long-distance or high-speed applications .
- Jacket Material: LSZH, PVC, or armored jackets influence durability and price; patc...
