Per-splice pricing often ranges from \$200 to \$600, depending on the equipment and skill required. Repair projects combine several cost categories. For most commercial projects, expect to pay \$50-\$150 per fusion splice point - but that number can swing in either direction based on the factors below. The "per splice" rate is the most.

Fusion Splicing: This method involves aligning two fiber ends and using an electric arc to melt them together, creating a seamless joint. As it turns out, fusion splicing makes a lot of sense for trunk fibers and locations where there are anywhere from 48.
