Mechanical splice kits are cheaper, typically \$100 to \$500. Additional tools include fiber strippers, protective sleeves, and cleaning supplies.

Site and Access Factors: Costs vary based on whether the splice is aerial, underground, or in confined spaces. Underground vaults or busy urban areas may require traffic control, safety measures, and additional crew, increasing total costs. Mobilization fees for travel and setup can range from \$150 to \$500, with remote sites adding more.
