A primary distribution box evenly distributes influent wastewater into a sedimentation tank, where gravity-driven settling removes solids, forming sludge at the bottom and scum at the surface.

Primary Distribution Box

The primary distribution box is a critical component located at the inlet of a primary sedimentation tank. Its main function is to evenly distribute incoming wastewater across the width or circumference of the tank, depending on whether the tank is rectangular or circular. Uniform distribution is essential to reduce turbulence, prevent short-circuiting, and ensure that all wastewater receives adequate detention time for effective settling. Properly designed distribution boxes often include baffles or flow spreaders to maintain consistent flow velocity and minimize resuspension of settled solids.

Sedimentation Tank (Primary Clarifier)

A sedimentation tank, also called a primary clarifier or settling tank, is designed to remove settleable solids, oils, and greases from wastewater before secondary treatment. The process relies on gravity: heavier particles settle to the bottom as primary sludge, while lighter materials, such as fats and oils, rise to the surface as scum. The clarified effluent then proceeds to secondary treatment stages, reducing biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) and total suspended solids (TSS), which improv...
