Optical fiber lines require a combination of physical, environmental, and material protections to ensure long-term reliability and performance.

Physical Protection

Fiber optic cables are inherently fragile, especially glass fibers, and need protection against mechanical stresses such as bending, crushing, or impact. Protective measures include:

- Armored cables: Steel or aluminum layers shield fibers from mechanical damage, rodents, and accidental impacts .
- Cable jackets: Materials like PVC, LSZH, TPU, and PE provide resistance to fire, moisture, chemicals, and crushing forces . PVC is common for indoor use, LSZH is preferred in fire-sensitive areas, TPU is used in industrial or tactical applications, and PE is ideal for outdoor and direct-burial installations .
- Conduits and ducts: Placing cables inside protective tubes or conduits prevents accidental digging damage and provides additional mechanical support .

Environmental Protection

Fiber optic lines must withstand environmental factors such as moisture, temperature extremes, UV exposure, and chemical contact:

- Water-blocking gels or tapes: Prevent moisture ingress in underground or outdoor cables
