1. Loss of Signal (LOS): The red light often signals that the router cannot communicate with your Internet Service Provider (ISP) due to a disrupted fiber signal. This can happen if the fiber optic cable is damaged, bent sharply, or has a faulty connector, which interrupts the light transmission inside the fiber cable . 2. ISP Outages: Temporary service interruptions from your ISP, such as maintenance, technical issues, or network congestion, can cause the red light to appear even if the fiber cable itself is intact . 3. Loose or Damaged Connections: Improperly seated fiber connectors, power cables, or Ethernet connections can prevent the router from establishing a stable link, triggering the red LOS light . 4. Router or ONT Malfunction: Internal hardware or firmware issues in the router or Optical Network Terminal (ONT) can also cause the red light, sometimes intermittently . 5. Environmental Factors: Excessive bending, tight coils, or pressure on the fiber cable (e.g., under skirting boards) can attenuate the signal, leading to intermittent red light flashes .

- Check for ISP Outages: Verify with your ISP whether there is a known service disruption in your area .
- Inspect the Fiber Cable: Look for visible bends, kinks, or damage. Ensure the cabl...
