Types of Cable Tray Brackets and Supports

1. Wall Brackets: These are used to mount cable trays securely to walls, providing stability and space-saving installation. They are typically made from hot-dip or sendzimir galvanized steel for corrosion resistance and high load capacity, suitable for power, data, and control cables in industrial and commercial settings . 2. Stand-Off Brackets: Designed to maintain a specific clearance from walls or surfaces, these brackets range from 50mm to 300mm and are ideal for routing trays without obstruction. They are often constructed from pre-galvanized or stainless steel for durability . 3. G Hanger Support Brackets: Used for overhead support of cable trays, trunking, or baskets, these brackets are available in various sizes (e.g., 100mm, 150mm) and provide robust support for suspended installations . 4. Trapeze Support Brackets: Pre-assembled for quick installation, trapeze brackets support wide trays with adjustable drop lengths, offering strong reinforcement for heavy cable loads . 5. Standard Fixing Brackets and Clamps: These include couplers, tees, crosses, and clamps that secure cable trays at joints, directional changes, or expansion points, ensuring structural integrity and preventing sagging .

All changes of direction must be supported in the immediate vicinity of the joints (distance ≤ 150 mm) by an appropriate supporting
