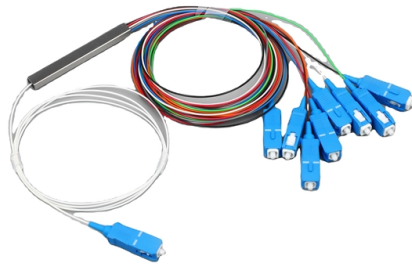

Increasing the longevity of the grounding system can be accomplished by the utilization of materials that are resistant to corrosion, such as copper or copper-clad steel, as well as protective coatings.

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm 2 (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm 2 must be used.
