

Requirements for the handle of the secondary distribution box on the construction site



Article Overview

The handle of a secondary distribution box must be durable, insulated, ergonomically accessible, and compliant with safety standards to ensure safe operation in harsh construction environments.

Material and Durability

The handle should be made of fireproof, insulating materials such as reinforced plastic or coated metal to prevent electrical shock and withstand high temperatures, rain, and mechanical impact . It must be robust enough to endure frequent use and potential collisions on a busy construction site.

Safety and Insulation

Handles must provide electrical insulation to protect operators from accidental contact with live components inside the box. This aligns with the requirement that all electrical appliances inside the box are mounted on insulating plates and that the metal base is properly grounded . Rubber or plastic coatings on the handle are recommended for additional protection.
