

Requirements for the installation distance of secondary distribution boxes



Article Overview

Secondary distribution boxes should generally be installed at a height of about 1.5 meters from the ground, with horizontal distances to connected equipment not exceeding 3 meters, and overall spacing following safety and leakage protection standards.

Vertical Installation Height

For residential and industrial setups, the recommended height for installing secondary distribution boxes is approximately 1.5 meters from the floor. This height ensures accessibility for maintenance while keeping the box out of reach of children and minimizing accidental contact with live components. In some industrial environments, the height may be adjusted depending on surrounding equipment and space constraints.

Horizontal Distance and Spacing

- The horizontal distance between a distribution box and fixed electrical equipment should generally not exceed 3 meters to ensure safe and efficient wiring connections.
- The total distance between distribution boxes and switch boxes should be carefully planned to maintain proper leakage protection and avoid interference, especially in multi-stage distribution systems.
