Overview

Fiber optic cables are made of glass or plastic fibers that transmit data as pulses of light, enabling extremely fast and stable internet connections compared to traditional copper cables . The "thin wire" you see in home setups is typically a single-mode fiber with a diameter of around 600 microns, which is much smaller than standard Ethernet cables . These cables are designed to be virtually invisible, allowing routing along baseboards, corners, or walls without cluttering your home .

Key Features

- **High-Speed Transmission:** Fiber can handle speeds up to 1 Gbps or higher for home networks, with potential for terabit-level capacity in professional setups .
- **Bend Tolerance:** Modern fibers, such as G.657.B3, allow multiple 90-degree bends with minimal signal loss, making installation flexible .
- **Connectors:** Common connectors include SC/APC, SC/UPC, and LC/APC, which ensure low back reflection and stable transmission .
- **Compatibility:** Fiber connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or directly to a fiber-ready router. Media converters are often used to convert fiber signals to Ethernet for standard router ports .
