Regulatory and Standards Overview

Optical cable duct construction is governed by international and industry-specific standards. ITU-T L.100 specifies the characteristics, mechanical and optical performance, and test methods for optical fiber cables installed in ducts and tunnels, including electrical continuity tests for metallic elements and environmental considerations for duct installations . The Fiber Optic Association (FOA) provides detailed safety guidelines covering eye protection, handling of fiber scraps, chemical exposure, and general construction safety, emphasizing compliance with OSHA rules in the U.S. . ESB Networks standards highlight duct depth, clearance, mechanical strength, and quality control measures to ensure long-term asset serviceability and safe access .

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Worker Safety

All personnel must wear standard construction PPE, including hard hats, safety glasses, gloves, and high-visibility clothing. Eye protection is mandatory when handling fiber optics to prevent injury from shards or sparks during fusion splicing .
