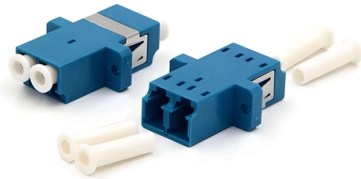


Safety of Combiner Boxes in Photovoltaic Power Stations

Role and Function

A PV combiner box aggregates the DC output from multiple solar panel strings into a single feed to the inverter, acting as a central hub for electrical distribution and safety management . Each string is typically protected by fuses or circuit breakers, which prevent overcurrent and short circuits from propagating through the system . This setup ensures that if one string experiences a fault, only that branch is isolated, avoiding a system-wide shutdown .

Electrical Safety Features

Modern combiner boxes incorporate multiple layers of protection:

- **Overcurrent Protection:** Fuses or circuit breakers prevent excessive current from damaging modules or wiring .
- **Reverse Current Protection:** Prevents backflow of current that can occur due to shading or mismatched strings .
- **Surge Protection Devices (SPDs):** Type 2 SPDs protect against voltage spikes from lightning or grid switching, especially for long DC cable runs
