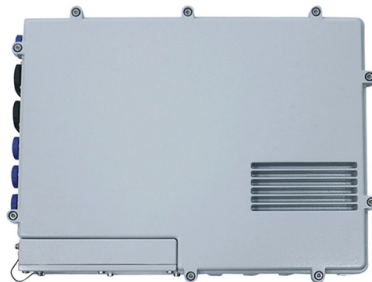


Samoa Fiber Optic Cable Project
