

Secondary Distribution Box 220V

A 220V supply can be connected to a secondary distribution box (sub panel) by using a properly rated feeder cable, breakers, and grounding system to safely distribute power to secondary circuits.

Overview of Secondary Distribution

A secondary distribution box, also known as a sub panel, is a smaller breaker panel connected to the main electrical panel to distribute power to specific areas or circuits within a building . It allows for localized control, additional circuit capacity, and easier maintenance without overloading the main panel. Secondary distribution boxes are commonly used in garages, basements, or large residential and commercial areas .

Wiring a 220V Sub Panel

- **Feeder Connection:** The sub panel is connected to the main panel via a feeder cable capable of carrying 220V. This cable typically includes two hot wires (L1 and L2), a neutral wire, and a ground wire . The feeder should be sized according to the total load of the sub panel.
- **Circuit Breakers:** The sub panel contains its own set of breakers to protect individual circuits. The main breaker in the sub panel may be optional if the feeder is already protected at the main panel . Each branch circuit is connected to the appropriate breaker.
- **Neutral and Ground Separation:** In a sub panel, the neutral bus and ground bus must be separated. The neutral bus is isolated from the panel enclosure, while the ground bus is bonded to the panel and connected to a grounding rod or system . This prevents neutral current from flowing through the panel enclosure, ensuring safety....
