Common Payment Methods

- **Advance Payment** Before project commencement, a portion of the total contract value (usually 10–30%) is paid to the supplier. This helps cover initial costs such as equipment procurement, labor mobilization, and permits, and encourages supplier commitment to the project ().
- **Installment or Milestone Payments** Payments are made in stages based on project milestones, such as completion of civil works, fiber splicing, or network activation. This ensures suppliers meet deadlines and allows project managers to adjust payments according to actual progress ().
- **Progress Payments** Similar to milestone payments, these are calculated based on the percentage of work completed over a defined period. For example, 10% may be paid after the first month, 20% after the second, and so on. This method maintains cash flow for suppliers while incentivizing timely completion ().
- **Final Payment and Settlement** After project completion and acceptance, the remaining balance is paid. Settlement methods can include bank transfers, checks, or electronic payment systems, depending on contractual agreements and regulatory compliance ()....
