Recommended Burial Depths

For terrestrial fiber optic installations, shallow burial typically ranges from 12 to 36 inches (30–90 cm) depending on soil type, traffic, and environmental conditions. In residential or commercial areas, 24–36 inches (60–90 cm) is common, while under sidewalks or light traffic zones, 12–24 inches (30–60 cm) may be acceptable if cables are placed in protective conduits. Armored cables can allow slightly shallower placement due to their mechanical protection, whereas unarmored cables require conduits to prevent damage.

Protective Measures

- **Conduits or Ducts:** Using PVC or HDPE conduits shields cables from accidental digging, rodents, and soil movement.
- **Armored Cables:** Steel tape or armored jackets provide mechanical protection against compression, plowing, or rodent activity.
- **Warning Tape:** Placing detectable warning tape about 12 inches above the cable alerts future excavators to the presence of buried fiber.
- **Sand or Gravel Bedding:** A 10–15 cm layer cushions the cable, reducing stress from soil pressure and minor surface impacts.
