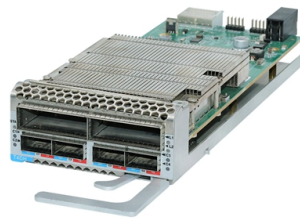

The enclosed geometry of trough-type trays acts as a physical barrier that blocks external electromagnetic fields from reaching the cables . This is particularly important in environments with high-voltage power lines, industrial machinery, or wireless communication signals, which can generate EMI that causes signal distortion, voltage fluctuations, or equipment malfunction .
