

Should the cable trays be sealed after cable installation

Yes, cable trays should generally be covered or sealed after cable installation to protect cables from physical damage, environmental exposure, and to comply with safety standards.

Purpose of Sealing or Covering Cable Trays

Cable trays are designed to support and organize electrical, control, and data cables, but they are often open structures. Covering or sealing trays after installation provides several benefits:

- **Physical Protection:** Covers shield cables from accidental impact, falling objects, or contact with personnel, especially in areas exposed to traffic or mechanical hazards .
- **Environmental Protection:** For outdoor installations, covers protect cables from ultraviolet (UV) radiation, moisture, dust, and other environmental factors that can degrade cable insulation over time .
- **Safety Compliance:** NEC Article 392 and OSHA guidelines recommend using covers or guards where trays are exposed to potential damage. Metallic trays may also serve as grounding conductors, and covers help maintain safe electrical continuity .
- **Cable Management:** Covers help maintain cable organization, prevent sagging, and reduce the risk of electromagnetic interference by keeping cables in place .
