A busbar is a metallic conductor that serves as a common connection point for incoming and outgoing electrical circuits, providing a low-impedance path for current distribution in electrical panels, switchgear, and industrial equipment . For small current applications, busbars are designed to handle lower amperages while maintaining thermal stability, mechanical strength, and safety.

Materials and Construction

- Copper: Offers excellent conductivity, strong mechanical strength, and efficient heat dissipation, making it ideal for compact panels .
- Aluminum: Lighter and more cost-effective, but requires a larger cross-sectional area to carry the same current safely .
- Form Factor: Small current busbars are often flat strips, laminated, or modular bars with tool-free connections for easy installation and expansion .
