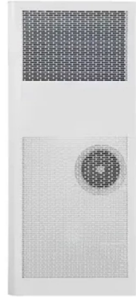


Spacing between communication equipment room cabinets



Overview

Make sure your room is an adequate size for the required number of equipment racks/cabinets. Each rack or cabinet needs a minimum of one meter of clearance in the front and back. General guidelines for sizing rooms are: 10 x 8 ft. This section includes the specifications for constructing and building out of Telecommunications Equipment Rooms (MDF/IDFs) to be used for supporting telecommunications and other special systems. Here's a practical guide based on international standards to help you design efficient and standards-compliant. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division 01 Specification Sections, apply to this Section. Minimum TER and TR size of 8' by 10'. Telecommunications mounting elements. Cabinets and equipment in the modified or expanded data center should be reasonably arranged according to the original power supply method and equipment power consumption. Adherence to this document should ensure potential problems are minimised and handovers completed in a straightforward and timely.
