Horizontal and vertical cable tray connectors are standardized to ensure compatibility, structural integrity, and proper cable management, with dimensions defined by tray width, depth, and material thickness.

Horizontal Connectors

Purpose: Horizontal connectors join two cable tray sections in the same plane, allowing straight runs or gradual bends. They include straight couplers, tees, and horizontal elbows. Key Specifications:

- Width: Matches the nominal inside width of the tray (common widths: 50 mm, 100 mm, 150 mm, 200 mm, 300 mm, 400 mm, 600 mm) with outside dimensions slightly larger due to side rail thickness .
- Depth/Side Rail Height: Typically ranges from 50 mm to 150 mm, controlling vertical stacking capacity and NEC fill compliance .
- Material Thickness: Usually 1.2 mm to 2.0 mm for steel trays; aluminum and stainless steel options vary based on load requirements .
- Load Class: Defined by the tray's ability to support cable weight over a specific span; horizontal connectors must maintain the same load rating as the tray .
- Construction: Steel or aluminum, often with pre-drilled holes for bolted connections; powder-coated or galvanized finishes for corrosion resistance . Common Types:...
