

Standard for Grounding Wire of Mobile Optical Distribution Box



Article Overview

The grounding wire for a mobile optical distribution box should typically be copper, sized at 6 AWG (US) or 6 mm² (international), with a grounding resistance of less than 0.1 ohm.

Wire Material and Size

For mobile optical distribution boxes, the grounding conductor is generally copper, which ensures low resistance and reliable conductivity. In the US market, a 10 AWG wire is commonly used for standard grounding, while for more robust applications, a 6 AWG copper wire is recommended to meet NEC and equipment manufacturer requirements. In international markets, a 6 mm² copper wire is typically specified. The wire should be U.L. listed and compatible with bonding clamps and grounding studs.

Grounding Configuration

The grounding system should connect the distribution box to a mounting plate and then to a central grounding point. This ensures that all metallic parts of the box, including the enclosure and internal components, are at the same potential, minimizing the risk of electrical shock or equipment damage. The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensure effective dissipation of stray currents
