

Standard support for cable trays



Article Overview

Cable tray support specifications depend on tray type, material, load, and environmental conditions, with standard support elements including wall brackets, suspended supports, and center supports installed according to spacing and load requirements.

General Support Principles

Cable trays are mechanical systems designed to support and route electrical and communication cables. According to DIN EN 61537, cable support systems must withstand mechanical loads, environmental conditions, and provide safe cable management . Support elements are used to attach trays to ceilings, walls, floors, or structural beams, and include:

- Wall brackets for side-mounted trays
 - Suspended supports for ceiling-mounted trays
 - Center supports for long spans or heavy loads
 - Mounting plates for junction boxes or devices attached to trays
- Support spacing is determined by tray type, material, and load. Ladder trays, which carry heavy power cables, require closer support spacing than lighter basket or channel trays. Typical rung spacing for ladder trays is 150–230 mm to maintain cable integrity .

- Support spacing: generally 1.5–3 meters depending on load and material....
