

Standard switches in household distribution boxes



Article Overview

Household distribution boxes typically include a main switch, single-pole and double-pole MCBs, and RCCBs to ensure safe and organized electrical distribution.

Main Switch

The main switch controls the entire electrical supply to the house. It is usually a double-pole MCB rated for the maximum current of the household, commonly 63A in domestic installations. This switch allows complete disconnection of power during maintenance or emergencies and serves as the primary control point for the distribution box .

Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs)

MCBs are automatic switches that protect individual circuits from overcurrent conditions. They are available in:

- Single-pole MCBs: Control and protect only the live wire, typically used for lighting and standard socket circuits.
- Double-pole MCBs: Control both live and neutral wires, often used for high-power appliances like water heaters, air conditioners, or kitchen equipment . MCBs trip automatically when the current exceeds the rated value, preventing overheating and potential fire hazards. They can be reset manually after resolving the fault....
