The standard ensures these systems can handle the physical and electrical loads they're exposed to, maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent to meet the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require.
