Duct fiber optic cables, designed for installation in pre-laid ducts, are typically loose tube or ribbon cables with protective jackets, strength members, and optional armor to ensure durability, flexibility, and high performance.

Cable Types and Construction

Duct fiber optic cables are engineered to navigate pre-installed ducts while providing protection against environmental and mechanical stresses. Key components include:

- **Optical Fibers:** Single-mode (e.g., G652D, G657A1) for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, or multimode (e.g., OM3, OM4) for shorter distances and high-speed networks .
- **Buffer Tubes:** Gel-filled or dry water-blocking tubes protect fibers from moisture and microbends .
- **Strength Members:** Aramid yarn (Kevlar), steel wires, or fiberglass rods resist tension during pulling or air-blown installation .
- **Outer Jacket:** Materials like LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), PE (polyethylene), or PVC provide flame resistance, UV protection, and chemical resistance .
- **Optional Armor:** Steel tape (GYTS) or aluminum tape (GYTA) adds extra protection in high-risk areas, such as near construction zones . Cable formats include loose tube cables for flexibility and high fiber counts, and ribbon cables for dense fiber packing and mass-fusion splicing .
