

The function of the optical port on a PoE switch

The optical port on a PoE switch allows you to extend network connectivity over fiber while still delivering power to PoE-enabled devices via Ethernet.

Understanding the Optical Port

Most PoE switches include SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or fiber ports that support fiber optic modules. These ports are used to connect switches over longer distances than copper Ethernet allows, often up to several kilometers, without signal degradation . The optical port itself does not provide PoE; it carries only data. PoE is delivered to devices through the Ethernet ports connected to the switch.

Choosing Fiber and Connectors

- **Fiber Type:** Single-mode fiber is ideal for long-distance connections, while multi-mode fiber is suitable for shorter distances within buildings or campuses .
- **Connectors:** Common connectors include LC, SC, or FP, depending on the SFP module and switch specifications .
- **SFP Modules:** Insert the appropriate SFP module into the optical port. Ensure the module matches the fiber type and distance requirements.

Connecting the Fiber

- Insert the SFP module into the optical port of the PoE switch.
- Connect the fiber cable to the SFP module, ensuring proper alignment and minim...
