The function is to provide a continuous, supported pathway that prevents cables from lying loose and vulnerable to physical damage. The system includes straight sections, fittings, and support hardware. Cable tray support structures form the basis of the cable tray system. The material of a cable support system is usually steel or stainless steel. Various galvanisation surfaces can be applied to improve corrosion protection. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
