Poor fiber optic router connectivity is often caused by physical cable issues, hardware faults, configuration errors, or environmental factors, and can usually be resolved through systematic troubleshooting.

Step 1: Inspect Physical Connections

Check all fiber optic cables for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connectors. Even minor bends or dust on connectors can cause signal loss and slow speeds. Clean connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oil, and ensure all cables are securely connected to the router and wall ports .

Step 2: Test Router and Hardware

- Restart your router by unplugging it for 60 seconds and plugging it back in to clear temporary glitches .
- Inspect the router for physical damage or wear; older routers may struggle to handle high-speed fiber connections or multiple devices .
- Ensure you are using Cat 6 or higher Ethernet cables for gigabit speeds .
- If your router has transceivers, swap them with known-good units to rule out hardware failure .
