Single-mode fibre optic cables are comprised of one glass fibre strand with a fairly slim core diameter. Far less internal reflection is involved as light rays pass through it, therefore reducing attenuation and allowing for far higher speed data transfer over longer distances. The following recommendations are general guidelines only. At a minimum, most residential installations require two strands of fiber, although adding additional strands is highly recommended.
