1. Direct Burial

Direct burial involves laying optical cables directly underground, typically at a depth of 1.2 meters or more in regular or hard soil. The process includes trench excavation, cable placement at the trench bottom, and backfilling with soil. Marker stones are often placed on the surface every 50 meters to facilitate future maintenance. This method provides strong protection for the cables but can be costly and challenging to expand .

2. Aerial Installation

Aerial installation places fiber optic cables over existing utility poles or power lines. This method is cost-effective and relatively quick, leveraging existing infrastructure. However, it is susceptible to weather conditions, interference from other utilities, and requires ongoing maintenance .

3. Pipeline (Underground Conduits)
